- B. All 4" and larger taps, meter, vault, associated materials and equipment, shall be provided and installed by the developer or owner at their cost in accordance with WWAWC specifications and requirement.
- C. Water meter type and size shall be determined by the WWAWC.
- D. Tap Fees are due when Developer/Owner agreement to construct water facilities is executed and as per said agreement.
- E. If water is available to property and no prior Tap Fee has been paid, then Tap Fee is due when owner signs Water Tap Contract.
- F. Additional tap fee for multi-family unit complex; all living units billed to one Meter, \$1,200 for each unit.
- G. Minimum bill shall be the regular minimum bill times the number of living units.
- H. The deposit shall be the regular deposit times the number of living units.
- I. \$0.15 per sprinkler head per month. Single family residential homes are exempt.
- J. \$15 per fire hydrant per month.
- K. Fire Line meters 4" and above customer deposit \$750.00 plus service charge.

This Policy replaces prior Meter & Fire Line Policy and becomes effective on March 1, 2024.
